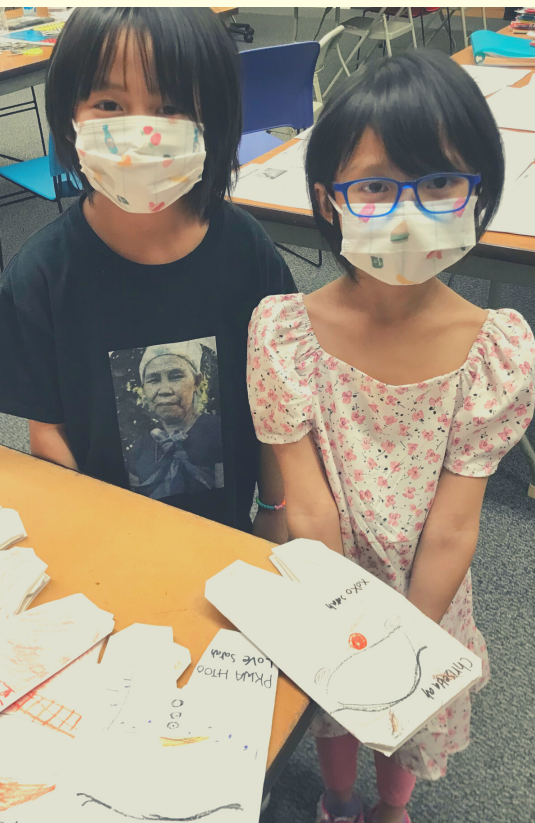
HAPPY HOLIDAYS! WE HOPE EVERYONE IS STAYING WELL!!
